## **PROCESS TO SIGN-UP**

Complete all the details, and select 'HOSPITAL TEAM' as **KINGS COLLEGE – ADULTS**

Say YES to pass on your details to 'local hospital team manager'. This will go to Tracey Griffiths

**CLICK** [REGISTER NOW](#)

**NOTE:** EVERYONE (even past competitors) need to set up a NEW LOGIN for 2022.  
ONE ENTRY PER APPLICATION. EACH INDIVIDUAL needs their own login

**First time registering:** Fill in details and then Click **REGISTER** (bottom of screen) to set up a new account  
You will receive an email from 'btg@gmsadmin.net' stating your 'username'  
Continuing with your registration:  
Answer all the questions which include 'chest size' (you may get a free t-shirt),  
basic bio etc

**SPORTS ENTRIES:** Be sure to select your correct age 'decade' e.g. 30-39 and if a standard of athleticism is required, be honest. E.g. archery – club archer or beginner (you can only be a beginner for 2 years, I believe – after that you are intermediate). Bows are provided if bow not owned (but do check). EVERYONE should try this as bows have been donated from local clubs for beginners – great fun!

Select all the sports you know you are able to compete in and following rules for min/max allowed entries

**NOT TO BE MISSED:** **Social – Opening Ceremony.** To be held at Millennium Square (check for changes). Generally only transplantees etc may parade but there is usually plenty of opportunity for the supporters to watch and be close. FREE. And it will be Thursday late afternoon.

**FUN FOR EVERYONE:** **Event – Donor Run (3km) or Donor Run (5km)**  
£6.50 per entrant. Saturday 30 July. City Docks. **READ the information button**  
Family members, friends etc can join

Also other social sports like golf, netball and short tennis, darts etc

**Returning after registering:** Use you new 'username' (usually starts GM.....) emailed by gms

**Number of sports allowed:** One sport per day  
plus evening Darts  
Four swim events and 4 athletic events PLUS relays  
The social events

**Cost:** If competing in FREE events, cost is £38 per competitor fee (adult) plus £15 Capitation fee (bit like an admin fee). In this case: £53.00  
Most social events will have a small charge

Adult Supporters over 18 yo, pay £22.50 registration fee. Child Supporter £12.50 registration fee (under 18yo).

**COMPLETING REGISTRATION:** You may SAVE your entries at any time HOWEVER, **you MUST 'SUBMIT' this form BEFORE/ON 22 MAY** (as stated above/previous page)  
On 'SUBMIT' you will need to pay the fee as stated above
